
Dear Colleagues,

Dear Sir,

With reference to your application dated 28.12.64 for affiliation to the proposed Degree College at Sonamukhi, P.O.Sonamukhi, Dist.Bankura, I am directed to inform you that the Executive Council has been pleased to grant affiliation to the proposed Sonamukhi College, Sonamukhi, Bankura with effect from the academic session 1966-67 in the following subjects and courses of studies subject to the conditions stated hereafter:-

U. E. Arts

English, Bengali, Sanskrit, History, Logic, Civics, Com.Geography, Com.Arithmetic & Book-keeping.

Three Year Degree Arts (Pass)

English, Bengali, History, Sanskrit, Economics and Philosophy.

Three Year Degree Commerce (Pass)

B.Com. with Auditing & Advanced Accountancy as Elective papers.

Permission has been granted to admit students to the U.E.Arts and the First Year Degree Arts & Commerce classes with effect from the commencement of the session 1966-67 and to present candidates for the U.E.Arts Examination in 1967 and the Three Year B.A./B.Com. (Pass) Part-I Examinations respectively in 1968 and not earlier.

Affiliation of the college is subject to the provisions of the University Ordinances relating to the conferment of Degrees, Titles etc. and subject to provisions being made by the

college of such requirements in respect of accommodation, equipment, teaching staff etc. as may be laid down by the University in respect of affiliation of the subjects mentioned above and fulfilment of the conditions laid down below:-

i) that a Principal and one lecturer in each of the following subjects should be appointed at the commencement of the session 1966-67:-

English, Bengali, History, Sanskrit, Economics, Philosophy and Commerce;

ii) that one additional lecturer in each of the following subjects should be appointed from the session 1967-68:-

English, Bengali, History, Sanskrit, Economics, Philosophy and Commerce;

iii) that another additional lecturer in Economics should be appointed for Commerce classes during the session 1967-68;

iv) that two Office Assistants, one trained Librarian and four Peons and Durwans should be appointed at the commencement of the session 1966-67;

v) that a college building according to approved plans should be constructed within a year from the date of affiliation and that the college classes be shifted to the new building from the session 1967-68;

vi) that the present accommodation offered by the Sonamukhi B.J.H.School may be utilised as a temporary measure for one year only; the permission for the use of school premises to hold the college classes is subject to the approval of the West Bengal Board of Secondary Education;

vii) that the college classes are to be held in the day. Separate rooms for the college library, Principal's office and Student Common Room should be provided;

viii) that the Principal and the lecturers of the college should be paid according to the present University Grants Commission scale of pay -

For Principal	... Rs.600-800/-
For Lecturer	... Rs.200-500/-

ix) that books for about Rs.18,000/- in the subjects of affiliation should be purchased, of which, books worth Rs.12,000/- be purchased during the session 1966-67 and the rest during the session 1967-68;

x) that the rate of tuition and other fees should be so framed as would not involve any competition with the same as prevalent in colleges in the neighbourhood;

xi) that a sum of Rs.25,000/- should always be kept as Reserve Fund to meet emergency expenditure. The amount may be withdrawn only after the approval of the Inspector of Colleges. The amount so withdrawn should be replenished so that a sum of Rs.25,000/- is always maintained as Reserve Fund;

xii) that the Governing Body should be constituted with the prior approval of the University within a month from the date of affiliation.
