The institution has effective welfare measures for teaching and non-teaching staff.

There are certain welfare measures in the institution for both teaching and non-teaching staff. Though some of the measures are state government policy related, they are implemented by the college authority. Again there are some measures which have been adopted by the college at the institutional level on its own initiative.

- For all the teaching and non-teaching staff, there is the provision of Casual Leave, Earned Leave, and Medical Leave as per the government rule. Apart from these, for the married female staff there are Maternity Leave and Child Care Leave as per government policy. There is also newly introduced Paternity Leave for married male staff. Duty Leave is granted for the permanent teaching faculty members for attending Orientation Program/Faculty Induction Program/Refresher Course/Academic Conference etc. For exigencies there are facilities of Special Leave.
- The college also provides xerox, prints and e-resources to the teachers.
- To encourage the faculty members to carry on research work, financial support is given from the college fund.
- There is the provision of **West Bengal Govt. Health Scheme** for the teaching staff and facility of SasthaSathi Scheme of the government for non-teaching staff.
- There is the provision for substantive employees to avail loans from Provident Fund. The college also advances a certain amount for the newly recruited employees. The financial aids are also provided by the college to the casual non-teaching staff by providing Ex-gratia bonus every year during the puja.

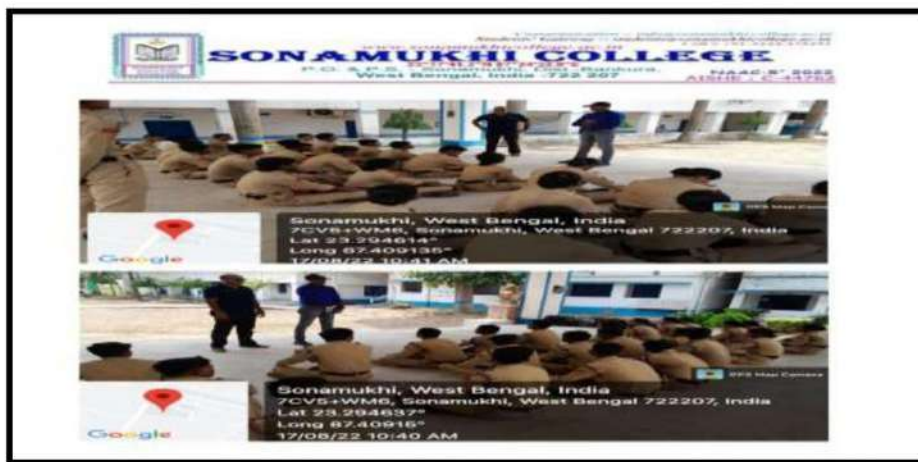
National Cadet Corps

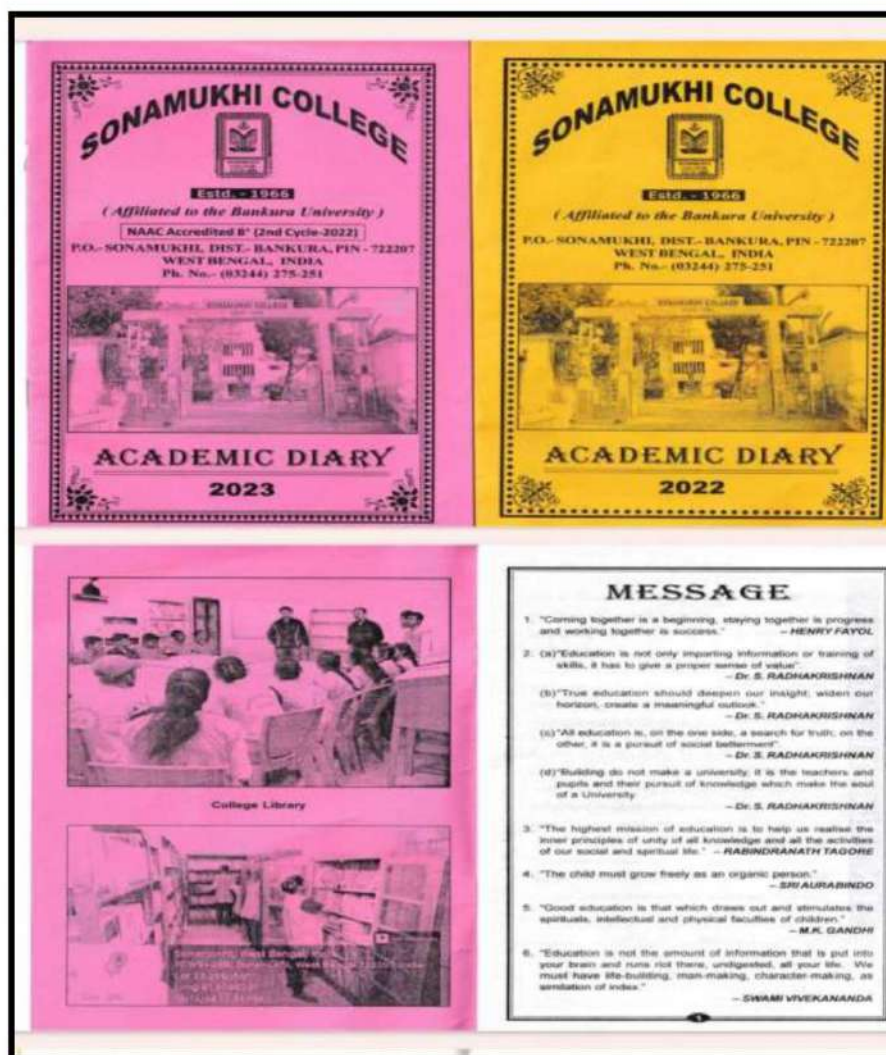

VISION

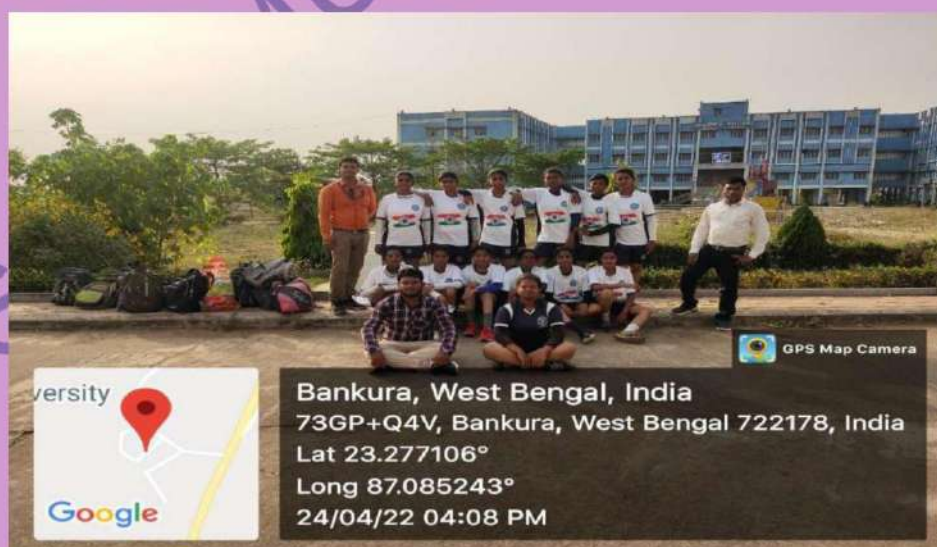

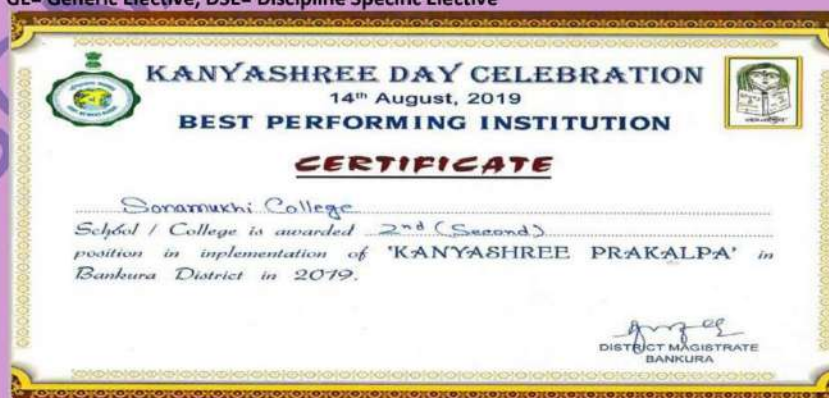

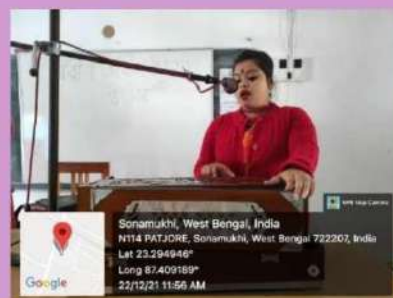

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Registration for Application: Online registration is mandatory for entering the admission procedure. Application for both the Honours and Programme courses can be made using one single registration.

Students who have passed H.S. or Equivalent Examination in 2020, 2021 and 2022 may apply for admission through the online registration. The link for registration is available in the home page of the college website <https://sonamukhicollege.ac.in>

Permanent and Own mobile number and **email id** of applicants are mandatory to fill up online application form for password confirmation as well as for future correspondences from Sonamukhi College and Bankura University (if got admitted).

During application candidates shall have to upload the scanned images of their Admit card and Marksheet of MP or equivalent Exam, Registration of H.S. or equivalent Exam, Marksheet of H.S. or equivalent Exam, Caste Certificate (if applicable) and P.H. Certificate (if applicable).

Activation of finally submitted online application will be done **AUTOMATICALLY** for merit list generation.

An applicant may apply in maximum four Honours subjects irrespective of faculty (science/Arts/Commerce) and maximum two Programme courses on the same online application form, if the candidate selects both option of Hons. & Programme.

The Eligibility Criteria for admission to different courses are available on Page- 23.

For applicants from Vocational Course: Students who have passed Vocational Engineering and Technology (with pass marks in Mathematics) equivalent to (10+2) level are eligible for admission to Pure Science Programme Course. Students who have passed Vocational Agriculture equivalent to (10+2) level are eligible for admission to Bio Science Programme Course. Students who have passed Vocational Business and Commerce equivalent to 10+2 are eligible for admission to Accountancy Honours Course.

Choice of Physical Education will be final after fitness test by the Department.

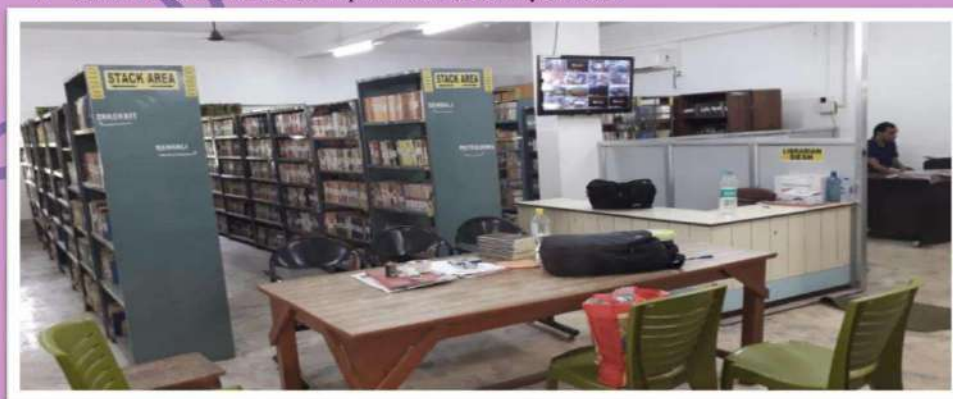

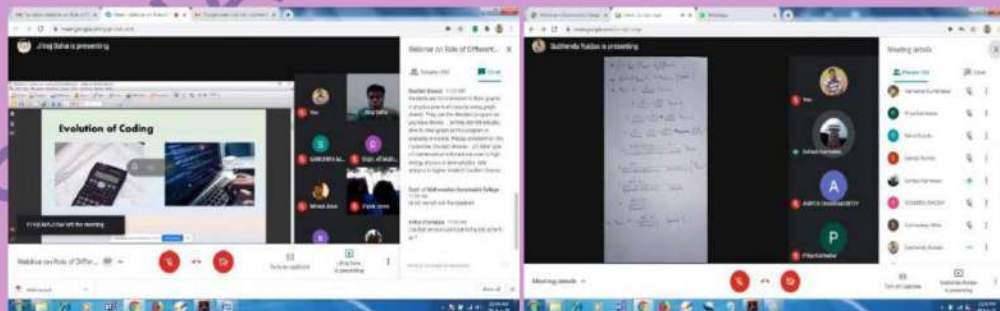
